To keep our magical land safe and fun for everyone, please read and adhere to these rules:

Parental Responsibility

- This is a venue licensed for unsupervised play. A responsible parent or guardian must supervise their child and must remain inside the play area at all times.
- You are responsible for your child's behavior, actions towards others, and their safety while in the playground.
- You may be held financially responsible for any damage caused by your child or yourself, be it intentional or unintentional, to the company's property and/or bodily harm or injury to its employees, vendors or its patrons.

Health & Hygiene

- Do not enter if your child is feeling unwell or showing signs of illness. We reserve the right to deny or revoke entry into the playground should your child begin to show symptoms of highly contagious illnesses such as conjunctivitis, impetigo, hand-foot-mouth disease, rashes, or excretions of bodily fluid that may create an unsanitary and unsafe environment for other patrons and employees.
- All guests must sanitize their hands upon entry.
- Grip socks must be worn at all times in play areas—no shoes or bare feet.
- Help us keep Raven's Wonderland clean: no food, gum, or drinks in the play area.
- For your peace of mind, alcohol spray bottles are provided for your convenience. We encourage the use of them to sanitize toys before and after use of your child.

Safety First

- No roughhousing, pushing, or bullying.
- Slides are one at a time, feet first only! Wait until the slider before you clear the landing.
- Climbing on outside walls, netting, or structures not meant for climbing is not allowed.
- Please read and adhere to the posted rules and limitations of each attraction. Please explain them to your child.
- Report any damaged equipment to staff immediately.

Belongings

- No personal toys or sharp objects are allowed inside play areas.
- Markers, crayons and other writing utensils are not allowed inside the play area.
- We are not responsible for lost or stolen items.

Time in Wonderland

- Respect all time limits if you're on a timed visit. Overstays will result in overtime fees.
- Be kind and share equipment with other little adventurers.

By entering Raven's Wonderland, you agree to these rules. We reserve the right to ask anyone to leave if behavior endangers others or disturbs the magical experience. Refunds will not be given for unused play time.

Indoor Playground Risk Acknowledgment & Consent

At Raven's Wonderland, we will do our best to create a safe, clean, and magical environment for your child to play and explore. However, as with any active play environment, certain risks are inherent and cannot be entirely eliminated.

Please carefully read the following list of potential risks associated with indoor playground use and acknowledge your understanding and acceptance below.

Potential Risks Include but Are Not Limited To:

- Minor injuries such as bruises, cuts, scrapes, or bumps from running, falling, or colliding with structures or other children.
- More serious injuries such as sprains, strains, fractures, or dislocations.
- Risk of falling from play structures, slides, climbing elements, or trampoline areas.
- Entrapment or pinching of fingers, toes, or clothing in equipment.
- Risk of injury due to misuse of playground equipment or failure to follow posted rules.
- Tripping hazards caused by toys, mats, or other children.
- Illnesses that may spread in a shared play space, especially if a child is sick or recently recovering.
- Emotional distress or behavioral issues resulting from overstimulation, crowding, or conflict with other children.
- Loss or damage to personal items brought into the facility.
- Possible allergic reactions to materials, cleaning products, or snacks brought by others.
- Unsupervised play can result in injury, especially if a parent or guardian is not actively monitoring their child.
- In rare cases, emergency situations (e.g., fire, power outage) may occur requiring evacuation or first aid.
